Location:	The Parkhotel Laurin is located in the historical centre of Bolzano just a few steps from the railway station and with direct access to the town's pedestrian area. The town's cathedral is also nearby.
History:	The Parkhotel Laurin was built by Maximilian Staffler in the years 1909-1910, designed by the architect bothers Ludwig. The hotel was completely renovated to designs by the architects Professor Boris Podrecca and Dr. Albert Mascotti between 1990 and 1998. The hotel is still privately owned by the Staffler family and is run by the director Roland Margesin.
Partners:	The Parkhotel Laurin is a member of the 'Worldhotels', an international association of independent hospitality establishments which offers a wide range of sales, marketing and distribution services to its affiliate hotels.

Travel directions:

Car:	Bolzano/Bozen is located on the A22 Brenner motorway, 280 km from Munich, 125 km from Innsbruck and approx. 150 km from Verona.
Rail:	Bolzano Central Station is just 50 m from the hotel. There are regular services to Innsbruck/Munich and Verona.
Air:	Bolzano airport is located 5 km from the town centre. There are regular departures for Rome.
The hotel:	100 rooms including 8 singles and 10 suites decorated in various styles. Furnishings are made from the choicest materials and pieces of antique furniture are found throughout the hotel.

Restaurants:

Laurin Restaurant: With seating for 45 diners, the Laurin restaurant is accommodated in an impressive art nouveau salon still in its original state. The finest dishes from the Italian and regional culinary traditions are on offer and the wine list includes a wide variety of superb local and Italian vinous delights. In addition to breakfast, lunch is served from 12 noon to 2.30 pm and dinner from 7 pm to 10.30 pm. The restaurant is closed at lunchtime on Sundays. An additional dining lounge is available with seating for 40.

The restaurant in the Laurin Park is open from May to September.

Laurin Bar: Bolzano/Bozen's favourite stylish evening venue with unique murals painted in 1911 by Bruno Goldschmidt. They portray the legend of King Laurin and lend the bar its distinctive style. The bar boasts a small terrace facing the hotel's park.

Smokers' lounge: The Laurin Bar also has a separate air-conditioned smokers' lounge with a wide selection of the choicest cigars.

Summer Lounge: In 2009 hotel park received a further attraction: a stylish lounge bar with cosy lounge furniture.

Public areas:

Conferences: The hotel offers a sumptuously equipped conference centre on the first floor with simultaneous interpreting and video-conferencing systems accommodating up to 160 persons.

Laurin Park: The hotel sits amid a historically landscaped park measuring 4,000 square metres. It is characterised by lush vegetation, a number of century-old trees provide shade and the park is embellished with numerous works by famous artists and plenty of benches to relax on.

Pool: The hotel's outdoor swimming pool is surrounded by sun loungers and is open to the Parkhotel's guests as well as to those of Greif, Laurin's sister hotel.
